



Performer Information and Application Process Norwich Pride, Saturday 27th July 2019

Thank you for enquiring about performing at Norwich Pride 2019. We are now accepting applications from performers who would like to volunteer their time to participate in the celebrations. You can do this by performing on the day on the Main Stage, inside the Acoustic Tent or as a Walkabout artist. You could also perform at an event in the lead up to the big day throughout the month of July. Applications close on 12th April 2019.

Norwich Pride is a celebration from the LGBT+ community for everyone, organised by LGBT+ volunteers and allies. Our aim is to turn Norwich into a rainbow: to make the last Saturday in July the most colourful and vibrant day on the city's calendar. Our mission is to live in a city where everyone can feel safe and proud to be themselves, every day, all year round. Norwich Pride is a family friendly event, so all performers must consider this with regard to the content and presentation of your act.

In 2019, we are celebrating 50 years since the Stonewall Riots in New York which sparked the modern LGBT+ rights movement and inspired the first Pride March. Along with Prides across the globe, we are calling the Pride Parade a Pride March this year to honour our history. We will be celebrating 50 years of campaigning for LGBT+ rights by designating July as a Pride Month in Norwich. From Schools Pride Week to specialist events and art shows, Norwich will be joining together to honour our history. During the big day on 27th July, we have programmed activities across Chapelfield Gardens and the Forum.

We believe that everyone who wants to be part of Norwich Pride and who is proud of their LGBT+ advocacy should agree and practice these values, which are taken from Norwich Pride core values.

By taking part in Norwich Pride, you must agree and understand our core values:

- We promote equality and celebrate diversity.
- We change negative attitudes and overcomes intolerance and prejudice of any kind.
- We treat people with respect at all times and avoid abusive or discriminatory language.
- We work positively and creatively to ensure everyone feels welcome whatever their age, gender, race, disability, sexual orientation, religion or belief.

We're asking everyone who would like to perform at Norwich Pride to complete an application form. This ensures everyone has had equal access to the different platforms Norwich Pride presents for performers. Applications close on 12th April 2019.
